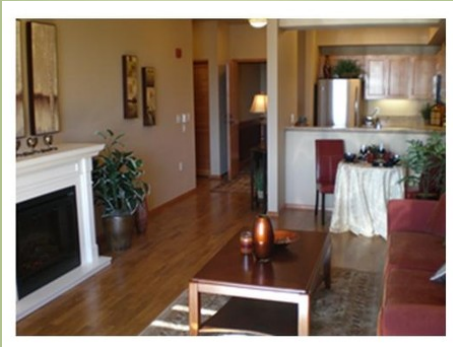
Springtime is finally here!

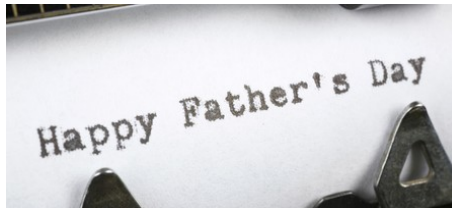
